The Homecoming Dance will be held in the gym from 7:00-11:00 p.m.

Tickets cost \$25.00. ONLINE SALES ONLY. Each Student ID should be used as the Access Code. DO NOT redeem your ticket until you are at the check in table the night of Homecoming! If your student ID does not work, your parent/guardian may not have submitted your Back to School Packet. See your Alpha Administrative Assistant to discuss why your ID is not working.

If you plan on bringing a guest, you must complete a Homecoming Guest Form. The form can be found in the Main Office and in the cafeteria. If you are bringing a guest from another PWCS school, they must have their administrator at their school fill out the bottom portion of the form. If the form is not filled out properly, your guest cannot attend Homecoming. Get this done as soon as possible and make sure the form is turned in before the deadline of October 2.

Remember that student access to various school functions (including Homecoming) will depend on the completion of the Back-to-School Packets in The Hub and consistent on-time attendance at school! Be sure to reach out to your student's counselor, teacher, or administrator with questions.
